### **April 1 - April 7, 2018**

### **April 8 - April 14, 2018**

**What orders have now been issued by the Higher Education Department for the students of Haryana under the Choice Based Credit System - Students will be able to study from any university after admission (University will be allowed to change)**

- A committee of UGC had recommended MHRD for this. In this case, Union HRD Minister Prakash Javadekar instructed all the states to make such a policy. In the policy, the Ministry of Human Resource Development spoke of implementing the scheme from 9th to PhD, but at present it will be implemented at the graduation level.
- A committee of 57 member faculty has been constituted for the revision of 11 different subjects in all the colleges across the state. This committee will give its recommendations on April 14, Kurukshetra University and Maharishi Dayanand University on April 15.
- Education Minister Ramvilas Sharma of Haryana says that under the Choice-based credit system, arrangements will be made that any University can be studied from any other University after taking admission. Students who decide which subjects to study in the subject are to be decided by themselves.
- At present the system is applicable in the DU. After the directive from the Ministry of Human Resource Development, the Higher Education Department has decided to finalize the policy to implement a Choice Based Credit System. About this, the letter has also been released from the department.
- If for some reason the education stops in the middle then the credit of such studies will be added further. Credits will be given as subject matter. Students will be given degrees on completion of credits. If the student wants to go to any other university in the meantime, his credit will be transferred there.

**In Haryana, who won 10 medals in National Gymnastics Championship in Gwalior - 8 years old Mahi Chauhan of village Vajirpur**

- In Gymnastics competition, 4 hundred participants from 13 states participated, in which the names of Mahi were included in the highest overall 11 players.

### **April 15 - 21st, 2018**

- This program was organized in celebration of 99 years of Jallianwala Bagh event.

- Swami Indraves Vidyapeeth Ashram of Rohtak was organized jointly under the auspices of Arya Samaj and Yuva Manhana Abhiyan in Titauli .
- In the function, the Chief Guest , Manish Grover, Cooperative Minister of Haryana , while presiding the President of Arya Pratibha Sabha, Principal Swami Aryavesh.

**Despite the government's incentive efforts, 40 thousand households of Palwal and Faridabad districts still do not have LPG gas connections. In order to provide LPG gas connections to all such families, State Food and Supplies Department has taken a decision to conduct surveys and a big campaign. In what form will be celebrated on 20th April with the same purpose - in the form of bright day**

- Additional Secretary, State Food and Supplies, Ramnivas told that three lakh families have been found in entire Haryana who do not have LPG gas connection.
- Ujjwala Day was celebrated on 37 places in the district on Friday under Village Swaraj Abhiyan. Union Minister of State Rao Inderjit Singh told that thousands of elite families have left subsidy for domestic gas at Prime Minister Narendra Modi's 'Gave It Up' appeal. The money is used by the government to burn the gas stove in the homes of the poor and the disadvantaged families.

**Which district in Haryana remained number one in wheat production - Palwal district**

- This time Palwal has left behind Karnal and Kaithal too.
- This was stated by deputy commissioner Maniram Sharma on behalf of Food Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs Department.
- So far 3 lakh 46 thousand metric tonnes of wheat has been procured in Palwal . Karnal has been on second place in the production of wheat . Been purchased within the Karnal district yet 3 lakh 29 thousand metric tons of wheat while Kaithal buy 2 lakh 56 thousand metric tonnes in the third is. So far 27 lakh 50 thousand metric tonnes of wheat has been procured in the entire state.
- Sonapat 2.56 Jind 2.43, Kurukshetra 1.59, Panipat 1.50, Ambala 1.42, Sirsa 1.42, Hisar 1.01 and Faridabad 1 lakh metric tonnes of wheat have been procured. In Fatehabad 95.966, 72.266 in Nuh, 72.079 in Jhajjar, 58.733 in Rohtak, 48.225 in Yamunanagar, 46.365 in Bhiwani, 41.542 in Gurgaon, 25.617 in Narnaul, 22.570 in Rewadi and 18.03 metric tonnes of wheat in Panchkula should be procured. - In Haryana, the purchasing agency - Flower Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs Department Ware, Haryana State Cooperative Supply and Marketing Federation Ltd. (HAFED) and Food Corporation of India and Haryana Warehousing Corporation procure wheat.
