**May 1 - 7, 2018**

### **Who has been appointed as the Chief Justice of Punjab and Haryana High Court - Justice AK Mittal (Ajay Kumar Mittal)**

- The then Chief Justice S.J. Wazifadar (Shivaksa Water) left his office on midnight on his retirement.
- Law Minister Captain Abhimanyu had issued a notification late night late night on May 4, 2018 to appoint Justice Mittal as the Acting Chief Justice. AK Mittal appointed Acting Chief Justice of Punjab and Haryana HC.

### **Understand, which player of Haryana won gold in 65 kg weight category in the International Karate Championship organized in Thailand? Nitin (resident of Indradgarh village of Indore village)**

- Nitin had earlier won gold medal in the Asia Championship held in Mumbai.

- In the case of pollution, Faridabad has got 172 points. Kanpur is the first place with the same pollution level 173.
- Faridabad was ranked 88th in the survey of 434 cities in the Clean India ranking by the Central Urban Development Ministry in the last year (2017).
- After this, on May 27, 2017, steps taken by Union Minister of State Krishnpal Gurjar, Environment Minister Vipul Goyal, all BJP MLAs and all the officers of Faridabad to make a smart city in the Corporation Auditorium. ### **World Red Cross Day - May 8**

#### **Where the first police commissioner of Haryana was set up - in Gurgaon**

**On May 8, at the Gurgaon Kingdom of Dreams, the inauguration of the Red Cross and St. Johns ambulance Haryana two mobile apps, on the occasion of World Red Cross, was attended by Governor Prof. Captain Singh Solanki was helped by the help of anyone who would sit anywhere in the country to help his known acquaintance in Haryana; what is the name of both of these apps - St. John's Ambulance India App and Red Cross Volunteer Blood Donors App**

- With the help of the Red Cross Voluntary Blood Donors App , it can be reached directly at the donor without delay. The list of blood donors registered in all 22 districts is also put in this app. There are 6038 donors in this list, whose number is expected to increase to 25 thousand soon. The app also has a map of blood banks, which will give the mobile number of the charge of the blood bank directly on the app.
- The Live Jones Ambulance India app will be provided with the connectivity, so that the person will be able to know how far the ambulance is available.

**What is the decision taken by the Human Resource Development Ministry (M.J.R.D.), while making changes in the vocationalization scheme in schools? Vocational course certificate will be available even after failure in class 12th or earlier.**

- Thousands of 9th class students take vocational courses in government schools, where they get certificates after completion of 4 years of studies. This certificate helps them get jobs after the 12th. However, due to failure in class 12th or earlier, the students did not get the certificates so far, but now it will not be so. Now the failure in the 10th and the 12th grade will not be obstructed by the vocational courses of the students. Even after failing in these classes, students will be given a certificate of vocational course.
- If the student leaves studies after failing in 10th or 12th due to any reasons, then he will get a certificate of professional course.
- So far, under the scheme, it was compulsory to run 2 courses in senior secondary schools. Now, as per the demand of schools, permission will be given to run a course.

**Due to the absence of information about Huda rules, plot allots who have not taken the Occupancy Certificate (OC) have been given an opportunity, now what is the last date for the OC application formation - before March 31, 2019 in Hooda Office Must apply**

- For this, a fee of Rs 10,000 will be deposited. At the same time, they will also need to find proofs that when they make their house.
- Two years ago, Hooda gave notice to plot allots who did not build a house on the plot and if the house was built then did not take the OC. After this, Alotians told in some cases that they had built the house 15 years ago. OC did not have the information, due to which the application did not. The matter was placed before the Chief Minister.
- On January 10, 2017, the Chief Minister had given such Altoes an opportunity to apply. He was asked to apply till October 31, 2017. During this time more than 300 Alotis had applied for OC. Meanwhile, the Haryana Traders Welfare Association urged

the Chief Minister to increase the period of the scheme. On this, the Chief Minister extended its deadline to March 31, 2019.

**Given the lack of teachers and the high number of students, the Department of Education will be able to teach students till the grade after passing the Diploma in Elementary Education Diploma (DLAD) holder's HTT examination - upto 8th**

- So far the students of the DLE students could be taught by the students of the 5th standard. Satyanarayan told from Haryana Teacher's Association that schools which are lacking in teachers and primary and middle schools are being operated in the same campus. These rules will apply to them.
- At the same time, the Haryana School Education Board Administration upgraded the DLDE course up to the eighth grade with four linguistic options. Usually DLAP has 9 topics. On taking one of these subjects, it has made it mandatory for the candidate to pass the language subject so that he can read upto 8th standard students. The board administration has now made Hindi and English compulsory and at the same time, Sanskrit, Urdu and Punjabi have been added as optional subjects. This rule is going to be applied to teachers coming to the new teachers as well as teachers who are studying in the first schools.
