

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQs) for Online Application

1. Why have you gone for Online Application?

Completing an Online Application is easy and fast compared to the Printed Application Form. The Online submission of the Application will reduce the errors and whole processing time for a student such as standing in queues at Banks to purchase Printed Application forms, take Demand Draft from bank, submission of completed Application form at the Regional Centers / TS EAMCET office, unexpected delays, uncertainty and confusion due to postal delay / receiving of Hall Tickets etc. In addition to this, online system provides efficient & consistent Application tracking information and the ability to search the applications easily. Since the inception of the online submission of the application in 2012 successfully it is working. Also for many competitive exams the online Application submission process is been being used. It is also to "SAVE PAPER and SAVE ENVIRONMENT".

2. How should I submit the Application form for TS EAMCET 2019?

For TS EAMCET 2019, Application has to be submitted ONLY through ONLINE mode. Please visit the TS EAMCET 2019 website <http://eamcet.tsche.ac.in> for more details. Read the instructions given in **USER GUIDE** before filling the Application. Be ready with the "mandatory details". It will guide you through the whole process.

Before filling the Online Application, keep the following mandatory details to fill in the appropriate fields.

3. What are the various modes of payment of Registration fees?

There are two modes of payment. a) Through TS / AP Online centers b) Through Debit / Credit Card or Net banking.

4. How do I know that my Application has been received after filling in the Online Application?

On successful submission of the Online Application, you will receive an SMS on your registered mobile with the Registration number. Further, your "Filled-in Online Application" containing all the details uploaded from database and filled-in by you along with the Registration number and the Barcode will be displayed instantly.

5. What should I do with the "Filled-in Application"?

The candidate has to take a print of the "Filled-in Application Form", keep a copy of this form and preserve it carefully. Use the Registration Number printed in the "Filled-in Application Form" for all future correspondence.

6. Should I upload any Certificate?

No, you do not have to upload any Certificate. However, submit the Filled-in Online Application to the Invigilator in the Examination Hall on the day of examination.

7. Should I upload my Photograph and Signature?

If your Qualifying examination is conducted by Intermediate Board of Education, Telangana / AP, and if you have passed the Qualifying Examination in any of the years - 2010 to 2018 or 2019, then you need not upload photo and signature as they are already available with TS EAMCET 2019 office. However, if you belong to CBSE / ICSC / Equivalent exam, then you have to upload passport Photo (file size less than 50KB and .jpg file format) and Signature (File size less than 30KB and .jpg file format) as and when prompted by the system during the filling of Online Application.

8. If I wish to appear for both streams Engineering (E) and Agriculture & Medical (AM), will I be allotted the same Test Centre or a different Test Centres?

You will be allotted different Test Centres to appear for both streams (E) and (AM).

9. I am an OBC category candidate. Should I enclose Category Certificate?

OC or OBC candidates need not submit any Certificate along with Application. However, OBC students have to produce the Category Certificate at the time of Counselling/Admission. SC / ST category students have to submit an attested copy of the Caste Certificate along with the Filled-In Application on the day of the entrance Examination.

10. What is the Registration fee for TS EAMCET 2019 examination?

Registration fee is as follows:

Engineering stream (E)	Rs. 800/- for Others and Ra. 400/- for SC/ST
Agriculture and Medical stream (AM)	Rs. 800/- for Others and Ra. 400/- for SC/ST
Both streams (E & AM)	Rs.1600/- for Others and Ra. 800/- for SC/ST
Last date for submission of Online Application without Late Fee	05-04-2019

Last date for submission with additional late fee of Rs. 500/-	11-04-2019
Last date for submission with additional Late fee of Rs. 1,000/-	17-04-2019
Last date for submission with additional Late fee of Rs. 5,000/-	24-04-2019
Last date for submission with additional Late fee of Rs. 10,000/-	28-04-2019

11. If I choose the Payment Gateway option, how should I submit the Online Application?

Before selecting the Debit / Credit card /Net banking payment mode for Registration fee, the candidate has to be ready with the required mandatory details. After payment, the Online Application will appear. Fill in all the mandatory details, read the declaration and SUBMIT.

12. What are the Boxes given in the bottom of the Filled in Online Application?

The boxes at the bottom of the Filled-in Online Application are meant for affixing photograph, signing and place for thumb impression of the candidate.

13. Do I need to post my application and attachments?

No, not Necessary.

14. After completing the Online Application process and generating printable Application, will I be able to login again to change my application data?

NO, after submission of the ONLINE Application, a “Filled-in Application” is generated. The candidate should take a print of the application form and hence, cannot modify the data. Therefore, the candidates are highly expected to be extra careful while filling the ONLINE Application. However, some of the fields (excluding Stream, Qualifying Exam Hall Ticket No., Candidate’s name, Father’s name, Date of Birth, Test Zone and SSC Hall Ticket details) in the Filled In Online Application Form can be edited by the Candidate during a permitted period. Still changes in the excluded fields are to be carried out, then, the candidate has to send a request to THE CONVENER, TS EAMCET 2019 or send an e-mail to **tseamcethelpdesk2019@gmail.com**

15. Inadvertently, I did some mistake while filling the details in Online Application. How to rectify it?

The candidates are expected to be very careful while filling the ONLINE Application. However, some of the fields (except Stream, Qualifying Exam Hall Ticket No., Candidate’s name, Father’s name, Date of Birth, Test Zone and SSC Hall Ticket details) in the Filled-in Application can be edited by the Candidates themselves, during the notified period. If the mistake still persists, then the candidate should to send a mail to Helpdesk at: **tseamcethelpdesk2019@gmail.com** or make a call to Helpdesk on 8499861703 / 9100718007.

16. I have missed to take a print of my Online Application at the end of my application process. How will I get access to it? Or If I misplace my copy of the “Filled In Online Application”, how could I get another copy?

You can log on to <http://eamcet.tsche.ac.in>, click on "Print Filled-in Application". Enter the Registration Number (sent to your registered mobile number and email Id), Payment Reference ID, Qualifying Examination Hall Ticket Number, Mobile Number & Date of Birth and take a printout.

17. What if I don't have an Email-id?

Email-Id is a mandatory as the Payment confirmation or any other future correspondence is only through the registered Email-id.

18. What if I don't have a Mobile number?

Mobile number is mandatory as the Payment confirmation or any other information is only through the registered Mobile number. Mobile number may also belong to your Parents / Guardian.

19. If I arrive at the TS EAMCET 2019 Examination Hall late by 1 minute, will I be allowed to take the exam?

Candidates appearing for TS EAMCET 2019 examination will NOT BE ALLOWED into the examination hall even if they are late by 1 minute. In view of such unwarranted situation, the candidates are advised to reach the Test Centre atleast one hour in advance.

20. Inadvertently, I pressed the Back / Refresh / ANY button during the Registration Fee Payment through Debit / Credit Card, will that effect my payment process?

It is strictly advised to avoid the operation of Back / Refresh / ANY buttons during the Registration Fee Payment through Debit / Credit Card as this will not only hamper the whole process but the application submission will also be incomplete. Hence, you are advised to have patience during the Online Payment through Bank.

21. I haven't found the answer to my question in the FAQs, what should I do?

The candidate is advised to go through ALL details thoroughly on the official TS EAMCET 2019 website <http://eamcet.tsche.ac.in>. 22. With the help of the TS / AP Online acquired Transaction Id. I have started filling the Online Application Form. Unfortunately, I did not complete the process by clicking the "SUBMIT" button and the "Filled-in Online Application" was not generated. Can I use the same Transaction Id. again and restart the filling of the Online Application Form?

Yes, the candidate can use the same Transaction Id. as long as you do not press the "Submit" button in Online Application.

23. I have registered for the Engineering (E) stream, later I wish to register for the Agriculture & Medical (AM) stream as I am eligible, can I transfer the already paid Registration Fee to (AM) stream.

No, the Registration Fee cannot be TRANSFERED.

24. I have paid the Registration Fee for the Engineering (E) stream, but I do not wish to take the TS EAMCET 2019 exam due to unavoidable reasons. Is the Registration Fee Refundable?

No, the Registration Fee is NOT REFUNDABLE.

25. Can I exchange the Transaction Id. with my friend?

No, the Transaction Id. is not TRANSFERABLE

26. Are the Help Line Centres (HLCs) meant for appearing TS EAMCET 2019 entrance test? No. These HLC are for certificate verification at the time of Counselling for admission to professional courses. The schedule will be notified by the competent authority at a later date.

27. I have studied Intermediate (BiPC) in 2017 and have passed Intermediate (Maths) in Private in 2018. Am I eligible to apply for Engineering (E) stream in TS EAMCET 2019?

No. As your major subjects in Intermediate (Regular) is BiPC, you are eligible to apply only for Agriculture and Medical (AM) stream in TS EAMCET 2019.

28. I have studied Intermediate (MPC) in 2017 and have passed Intermediate (Biology) in Private in 2018. Am I eligible to apply for Agriculture and Medical (AM) stream in TS EAMCET 2019?

No. As your major subjects in Intermediate (Regular) is MPC, you are eligible to apply only for Engineering (E) stream in TS EAMCET 2019.
